The Baltimore City Office of Information and Technology (BCIT) has completed its review of Council Bill 23-0337 for the purpose of providing a Supplementary General Fund Capital Appropriation in the amount of \$1,000,000.00 to the Baltimore City Office of Information and Technology – PRJ002418 (923059 117-059 Upgrade Application Integration and Infrastructure), to provide funding for upgrading information technology application integration and infrastructure; and providing for a special effective date.

This supplemental appropriation of \$1,000,000.00 was committed from the surplus and is made available due to material change in circumstances since the Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2023 was formulated. This project will support upgrades to application integration and enterprise applications such as the replacement of the city’s property tax system. Improving the level of integration among various city systems will improve system operability and interagency performance.
