**AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING**

FOR the purpose of designating the Canton Railroad Transfer Bridge, an improvement only parcel located at Ward 01, Section 10, Block 1902-F, Lot 001, as an historical landmark: exterior.

BY adding  
Article 6 - Historical and Architectural Preservation  
Sections 18A-5  
Baltimore City Code  
(Edition 2000)

**SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

**Subtitle 18A. Landmark List: Exteriors – 2020s**

**§ 18A-5. CANTON RAILROAD TRANSFER BRIDGE.**

CANTON RAILROAD TRANSFER BRIDGE, IMPROVEMENT ONLY PARCEL: WARD 01,  
SECTION 10, BLOCK 1902-F, LOT 001.

**SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30<sup>th</sup> day after the date it is enacted.
