## AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING

### **Rezoning – 1419 to 1431 Bank Street and 409 South Spring Street**

- 2 FOR the purpose of changing the zoning for the properties known as 1419 to 1431 Bank Street
  - (Block 1433, Lots 043, 044, 045, 046, 047, and 048/050) and 409 South Spring Street
  - (Block 1433, Lot 051/060), as outlined in red on the accompanying plat, from the R-8 and
- 5 IMU-1 Zoning Districts to the C-2 Zoning District, and providing for a special effective date.

#### 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That

- 13 Sheet 56 of the Zoning District Maps is amended by changing from the R-8 Zoning District to
- 14 the C-2 Zoning District the properties known as 1419 to 1431 Bank Street (Block 1433,
- 15 Lots 043, 044, 045, 046, 047, and 048/050), and from the IMU-2 Zoning District to the C-2
- 16 Zoning District the property known as 409 South Spring Street (Block 1433, Lot 051/060), as
- 17 outlined in red on the plat accompanying this Ordinance.

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS indicate matter added to existing law. [Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law. <u>Underlining</u> indicates matter added to the bill by amendment. Strike out indicates matter stricken from the bill by amendment or deleted from existing law by amendment.

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SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That as evidence of the authenticity of the 1 accompanying plat and in order to give notice to the agencies that administer the City Zoning 2 Ordinance: (i) when the City Council passes this Ordinance, the President of the City Council 3 shall sign the plat; (ii) when the Mayor approves this Ordinance, the Mayor shall sign the plat; 4 5 and (iii) the Director of Finance then shall transmit a copy of this Ordinance and the plat to the 6 Board of Municipal and Zoning Appeals, the Planning Commission, the Commissioner of Housing and Community Development, the Supervisor of Assessments for Baltimore City, and 7 8 the Zoning Administrator.

9 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is 10 enacted.
