The Baltimore City Office of Information and Technology (BCIT) has completed its review of Council Bill 23-0368 Real Property Tax Credit for Energy Conservation Devices. The purpose of this bill is to amend the energy conservation devices real property tax credit; and providing for a special effective date by repealing and re-ordaining, with amendments Article 28 - Taxes Section 10-31 Baltimore City Code (Edition 2000).

BCIT defers to the Department of Finance (DOF), the lead agency as it relates to Council Bill 23-0368. Baltimore City enacted Ordinance 22-162 in August 2022 which established the real property tax credit for energy conservation devices. Since then, BCIT has worked with DOF to implement the requirements of this program. There is no additional work needed in order to comply with the amendment.
