Major Issues Discussed

- 1. Chairman Conway called the hearing to order and introduced the committee members in attendance.
- 2. Councilman Burnett discussed the background of the bill and summarized the bill. Also noted that amendments were being circulated for the bill.
- 3. Agencies introduced themselves and reviewed their agency reports.

 - c. Has a budget request for the Mayor's Office of LGBTQ Affairs been submitted? (Not at the time of the hearing)
- 5. Chairman Conway recognized participants for public testimony. Several participants testified in support of the bill and asked for a vote on the bill at the hearing.
- 6. Chairman Conway explained that the committee would not vote on the bill at this hearing to give members the chance to review and consider the bill and proposed amendments.
- 7. Councilman Burnett made a closing statement and indicated that additional hearings and voting sessions would be scheduled after the budget process and would be communicated to constituents.
- 8. Chairman Conway recessed the hearing.
