Recitals

The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents income tax funds in excess of the 13 14 revenue relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2023.

- 18 This appropriation is made necessary by a material change in circumstances since the
- Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2023 was formulated or is for a new program that could 19 not have been reasonably anticipated when that Ordinance of Estimates was formulated. 20
- On December 21, 2022, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City 21 22 Council.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That
\$1,250,000.00 shall be made available to the Mayor's Office of Information and Technology –
PRJ001617 (914017 Enterprise IT Infrastructure) as a Supplementary General Fund Capital
Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2023, to provide funding for enterprise information technology
infrastructure. The source of revenue for this appropriation are income tax funds in excess of the
amount from this source that was relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy
required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2023.

8 **SECTION 2.** AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is 9 enacted.
