Recitals

14 The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents income tax funds in excess of the

- This additional revenue could not have been reasonably anticipated when the Ordinance of
 Estimates for Fiscal Year 2023 was formulated.
- 19 This appropriation is made necessary by a material change in circumstances since the 20 Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2023 was formulated or is for a new program that could 21 not have been reasonably anticipated when that Ordinance of Estimates was formulated.
- On December 21, 2022, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the CityCouncil.

5 upgrading information technology application integration and infrastructure. The source of

6 revenue for this appropriation are income tax funds in excess of the amount from this source that

7 was relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the

8 budget for Fiscal Year 2023.
