## **Major Issues Discussed**

- 1. Chairman Costello, primary sponsor of the legislation gave opening remarks. He talked about the background of the Benefit District and about why the map is being amended."
- 2. Chairman Costello went over the agency reports with the agency representatives.
- 3. Mr. Laria also talked about the background of the District: Some highlights of his testimony were:
  - O Votes from residents needed to approve the legislation/amendment
  - O What the amendment would do to the district and/or boundaries of same
  - o Showed map of boundary/District
  - o Talked about events and promotions that occurred within the District, stating information is provided on their website
  - o Discussion surrounding "Locke Landing"
    - Locke Landing does not have any TIF's objectives, therefore should make some kind of contribution to the District
    - About what Locke Landing should or should not be contributing to the Special District
  - o Amendment
    - Two amendments were submitted
    - Opposed the legislation as is
    - Hopes an equitable solution(s) can be made regarding Lock Landing property
- 4. Ms. Hecker testified and talked about how the legislation will affect the District. She also commented on the Locke Landing Property; about what Locke Landing should and/or should not be paying for.
- 5. Committee/councilmembers asked questions, gave comments and/or asked for clarification. Some were:
  - o Questions about the Special District/Property Owners/Other Entities within the District/MAP
    - Explain how the calculation works:
      - How formula (assessments/value) was established
      - When was the formula established?
      - Why wasn't Locke Landing purchased?
        - o If this property is excluded what happens? Who will pick up the costs?
      - What is Under Armour's role and/or responsibilities to the Special District?
      - After the development how much will the residents have to pay?
  - Board Members
    - Explain what the breakdown is for the Board members who are making decisions for the District
      - Who is on it and how was the Board created
      - Who are the board members and what are their term limits
      - Per Mr. Laria, "believes Locke Landing should have a representative on the Board
  - Special Events/Promotions/Developments
    - Comment: Listening to updates of the area and/or District is very interesting!
    - Tell us about some of the promotions/events and/or developments happening in the District which connects with the rest of the City.

Requested by member Middleton: Would like a briefing and/or an update regarding the promotions, events, and etc. happening in the District which connects with the rest of the City.
