1.6. HVAC SYSTEMS AND COMPONENTS, AND OTHER OPAQUE OBJECTS MOUNTED ABOVE THE ROOF.
2. PORTIONS OF THE ROOF SHADED DURING THE PEAK SUN ANGLE ON THE SUMMER SOLSTICE BY PERMANENT FEATURES OF THE BUILDING OR BY PERMANENT FEATURES OF ADJACENT BUILDINGS.
3. PORTIONS OF ROOFS THAT ARE BALLASTED WITH A MINIMUM STONE BALLAST OF 17 PSF (74 KG/M2) OR 23 PSF (117 KG/M2) PAVERS.
4. ROOFS WHERE NOT LESS THAN 75 PERCENT OF THE ROOF AREA COMPLIES WITH ONE OR MORE OF THE EXCEPTIONS TO THIS SECTION.
