Major Issues Discussed

- 1. Chairman Conway called the hearing to order, read the bill for LO21-0015 & LO23-0041 and introduced the committee members in attendance.
- 2. Chief Matz and Dr. Lawner presented on EMS statistics and operations (presentation in the file) and responded to committee member questions. Topics included:
 - a. EMS trends in neighborhoods
 - i. Discussed indicators and how resources are moved in the City.
 - b. Preempting addiction
 - i. Discussed the use of medication for people suffering from addiction but also the need for follow-up resources and the need to educate people on other resources such as 988 for mental health crises.
 - c. Correcting for population density and making sure that resources are distributed correctly.
 - i. Discussed a report that would look at census population v raw data.
 - d. BCRI underfunded
 - e. Language barrier issues
 - i. Discussed the use and limitations of the language line.
 - ii. Hiring more bilingual staff particularly Spanish-speaking staff members.
 - iii. Use of additional technology including AI systems to help meet needs.
 - 1. Hiring of local tech company to help.
 - f. How are we thinking about leveraging opioid restitution funds?
 - i. Part of the issue is that BCFD is not set up for case management and needs partners to offer wrap-around services.
 - g. Would BCFD support a safe injection site?
 - i. Defer to health department.
 - h. Why are stabilization centers sending patients to the ER?
 - i. Patients can sometimes require more care than the center can provide prompting them to go to the ER or in some cases back to the ER.
- 3. Chairman Conway recessed the hearing.
