<u>INTRODUCTION</u> - Street Encroachment – 229 East Montgomery Street

<u>PURPOSE/PLANS</u> - For the purpose of permitting, subject to certain conditions, the construction and maintenance of a portion of a building, projecting into the public right-of-way on the east side of the property known as 229 East Montgomery Street; and providing for a special effective date.

<u>COMMENTS</u> – Council Bill 23-0394 looks to permit encroachment on public right-of-way on the east side of the property known as 229 East Montgomery Street. The property owner is seeking permission to construct an upper-level addition to an existing rowhome property, a portion of which will extend over City right-of-way. The property owner has entered into a formal Right of Entry Agreement, requiring the payment of \$750 to the City of Baltimore for the street encroachment. Moving forward, there will be additional property taxes levied for the addition square footage totaling 34.5 square feet.

<u>AGENCY/DEPARTMENT POSTION</u> – For the reasons outlined above, the Baltimore City Department of Transportation **supports** the advancement of Council Bill 23-0394.
