The Department of Planning is in receipt of City Council Bill #23-0391, which is for the purpose of condemning and closing a portion of Boston Street, bounded by the east side of Haven Street, the southernmost property line of 1201 South Haven, LLC, the west side of Canton Railroad Right-of-Way, and the north side of Boston Street, as shown on a plat numbered 307-A-22A, dated March 17, 2022, and filed in the Department of Transportation; and providing for a special effective date.

The Department of Planning recommends **approval** of City Council Bill #23-0391, as this would provide for redevelopment of the adjacent parcel with new commercial investment.
