- sell, at either public or private sale, all the interest of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore in
- 14 the property located at 14 18 Light Street (Block 0660, Lots 0001 and 003A), also known as
- 7 East Redwood Street, a 20-story building, together with 3 below ground levels, containing
- 16 205,039 square feet, more or less, this property being no longer needed for public use.
- 17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That no deed may pass under this Ordinance
- 18 unless the deed has been approved by the City Solicitor.
- 19 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is
