4 Park Heights Avenue, Woodland Avenue, Denmore Avenue, and West Garrison Avenue, as  
5 shown on a plat numbered 317-A-28A dated March 6, 2023, and filed in the Department of  
6 Transportation; and providing for a special effective date.

15 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE**, That the  
16 Department of Transportation shall proceed to condemn and close a 20 foot alley and two 10  
17 foot alleys bounded by Park Heights Avenue, Woodland Avenue, Denmore Avenue, and West  
18 Garrison Avenue, and more particularly described as follows:
