**INTRODUCTION** - Zoning - Variance - Side Yard - 6709 Western Run Drive

<u>PURPOSE/PLANS</u> - For the purpose of granting a variance from certain side yard regulations in the R-1E Zoning District for the expansion of a residential dwelling on the property known as 6709 Western Run Drive (Block 4250, Lot 016), as outlined in red on the accompanying plat.

<u>COMMENTS</u> – Council Bill 23-0439 seeks to grant a variance at 6709 Western Run Drive for a side yard expansion in the R-1E Zoning District. 6709 Western Run Drive is in the Cross Country neighborhood in Northwest Baltimore. The R-1E Zoning District allows for detached dwellings located upon lots of 9,000 square feet or more.
