25 26	THE BRUNT STREET AREA CONSISTS OF THE 2100 BLOCK OF BRUNT <del>STREET, ODD SIDE ONLY.</del> <u>STREET.</u>

- 1 (B) PARKING RESTRICTIONS.

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- EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, PARKING
  FOR NON-PERMIT HOLDERS IN AREA IS LIMITED TO 2 HOURS IN ANY 1 OR MORE
  PARKING SPOTS MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY, FROM 7:00 A.M. TO 7:00 P.M.
- 6 (2) ADDITIONAL RESTRICTION.
- IN ADDITION TO THE RESTRICTIONS UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION,
  PARKING FOR NON-PERMIT HOLDERS IS PROHIBITED SATURDAY AND SUNDAY.
- 9 (C) PERMIT LIMITS.
- 10 EACH DWELLING UNIT WITHIN AREA \_\_\_\_ IS ELIGIBLE FOR:
- 11 (1) UP TO 4 RESIDENT PERMITS; AND
- 12 (2) UP TO 2 VISITOR PERMITS.
- 13 (D) SIGNAGE.
- 14 RESIDENTIAL PARKING PERMIT RESTRICTING SIGNAGE WILL BE PLACED ALONG ALL
- PROPERTIES <u>ON THE ODD SIDE OF THE 2100 BLOCK</u> THAT ARE PERMIT-ELIGIBLE, WITH THE
   EXCLUSION OF SCHOOLS, CHURCHES, AND BUSINESSES.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30<sup>th</sup> day
 after the date it is enacted.
