14	for over 40 years. Cottage Avenue Park is a place where all community people feel welcomed.	
15	Cottage Avenue Park has become a place where all accomplishments are celebrated, and it	
16	remains a place where the surrounding communities have appreciated what this green space	
17	brings to their lives. Cottage Avenue Park is the place where everyone is known as family.	
18	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the
