23 24	(1) ESTABLISH AN INTERNAL CITISTAT PROCESS TO IMPROVE PRINCIPAL AGENCY PERFORMANCE;
25 26	(2) MANAGE MONITOR PROGRESS ON THE AGENCY'S ANNUAL PERFORMANCE MANAGEMENT AGREEMENT PLAN;
27 28	(3) DEVELOP <del>AND IMPLEMENT</del> PLANS TO ADDRESS GAPS IN MUNICIPAL SERVICE DELIVERY OUTCOMES; <u>AND</u>
29 30	(4) REPORT TO THE OFFICE PROGRAM ANY RELEVANT DATA REQUESTED BY THE OFFICE; AND
31 32	(5) ASSIST THE OFFICE TO COMPLETE OTHER SUCH FUNCTIONS AS MAY BE ASSIGNED BY THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR.

#### 1 (B) DATA DRIVEN OFFICER.

EACH PRINCIPAL AGENCY SHALL IDENTIFY A DATA-DRIVEN OFFICER WHO SHALL REPORT
 DIRECTLY TO THE HEAD OF THE AGENCY AND BE RESPONSIBLE FOR MANAGING THAT
 AGENCY'S CITISTAT PROCESS.

## 5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect 180 days
