- 3 (1) WHO IS A RESIDENT OF BALTIMORE CITY; AND
- 4 (2) WHOSE COUNTRY OF ORIGIN IS A COUNTRY OTHER THAN THE UNITED STATES.
- 5 (D) *OFFICE*.
- 6 "OFFICE" MEANS THE MAYOR'S OFFICE OF IMMIGRANT AFFAIRS.

- THE PURPOSE OF THE OFFICE IS TO PROMOTE THE WELL-BEING, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT,
 AND INTEGRATION OF BALTIMORE CITY'S IMMIGRANT COMMUNITIES.
- 12 § 54-4. OFFICE POWERS AND DUTIES.
- 13 THE OFFICE SHALL HAVE THE POWER AND DUTY TO PERFORM THE FOLLOWING FUNCTIONS:
- 14 (1) ADVISE THE MAYOR, CITY COUNCIL, AND CITY AGENCIES ON WAYS TO ENHANCE AND
 15 IMPROVE ACCESS TO CITY SERVICES AND RESOURCES FOR IMMIGRANTS;
- 16 (2) ADVISE THE MAYOR, CITY COUNCIL, AND CITY AGENCIES ON WAYS TO STRENGTHEN
 17 OPPORTUNITIES FOR IMMIGRANTS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE CIVIC LIFE OF THE CITY;
- 18 (3) IMPLEMENT AND COORDINATE CITY POLICIES REGARDING ISSUES AFFECTING
 19 IMMIGRANT COMMUNITIES;
- 20 (4) ADVOCATE FOR EQUAL TREATMENT OF IMMIGRANTS AND EQUITABLE ACCESS TO CITY
 21 SERVICES;
- (5) REVIEW PROPOSED LEGISLATION REFERRED TO THE OFFICE BY THE CITY COUNCIL AND
 ASSESS ITS IMPACT ON THE ECONOMIC, PHYSICAL, SOCIAL, EMOTIONAL, AND
 INTELLECTUAL WELFARE OF IMMIGRANTS;
- (6) IMPROVE THE SERVICES AVAILABLE TO IMMIGRANTS BY ADVOCATING FOR CHANGES
 IN:
- 27 (I) PUBLIC POLICY;
- 28 (II) SERVICE DELIVERY; AND
- 29 (III) FUNDING;

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- (7) DEVELOP, IMPLEMENT, AND COORDINATE POLICIES THAT FACILITATE CITY AGENCIES' COMPLIANCE WITH ALL FEDERAL, STATE, AND LOCAL LANGUAGE ACCESS LAWS; (8) ADVANCE THE OFFICE'S MISSION BY WORKING IN PARTNERSHIP WITH: (I) CITY AGENCIES; (II) CITY BOARDS; (III) CITY COMMISSIONS; (IV) COMMUNITY ORGANIZATIONS; AND (V) THE PRIVATE SECTOR; (9) SERVE AS A LIAISON BETWEEN THE CITY AND ITS IMMIGRANT COMMUNITIES; (10) ESTABLISH AND STAFF COMMUNITY ADVISORY GROUPS TO PROVIDE STRATEGIC GUIDANCE AND MONITORING OF INITIATIVES RELEVANT TO THE PURPOSE OF THE **OFFICE**; (11) SOLICIT COMMUNITY AND STAKEHOLDER INPUT REGARDING THE ACTIVITIES OF THE OFFICE, INCLUDING CONSULTATIONS WITH CITY AGENCIES, BOARDS, AND COMMISSIONS ON IMPLEMENTATION OF PROGRAMS AND SERVICES RELEVANT TO IMMIGRANTS; AND

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- 19 (A) IN GENERAL.
- THERE IS A DIRECTOR OF IMMIGRANT AFFAIRS, WHO IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE
 ADMINISTRATION AND OVERSIGHT OF THE OFFICE.
- 22 (B) APPOINTMENT.
- THE DIRECTOR IS APPOINTED BY THE MAYOR IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE IV, § 6 OF
 THE CITY CHARTER.
- 25 (C) *SALARY*.
- THE DIRECTOR SHALL RECEIVE SUCH SALARY AS MAY BE PROVIDED IN THE ORDINANCE OF
 ESTIMATES.
- 28 § 54-6. STAFF AND BUDGET.
- 29 (A) *STAFF*.
- 30 THE OFFICE MAY EMPLOY STAFF IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ORDINANCE OF ESTIMATES.

- THE OFFICE MAY EXPEND FUNDS AUTHORIZED IN THE ORDINANCE OF ESTIMATES OR ANY
 SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION.

4 **§ 54-7. ANNUAL REPORT.**

- 5 ON OR BEFORE JUNE 30 OF EACH YEAR, THE OFFICE SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE MAYOR 6 AND CITY COUNCIL DETAILING:
- 7 (1) THE ACTIVITIES OF THE OFFICE; AND
- 8 (2) ANY SPECIFIC POLICY OR LEGISLATIVE PROPOSALS TO ADVANCE THE GOALS OF THE
 9 OFFICE AND THE NEEDS OF IMMIGRANT COMMUNITIES IN BALTIMORE.

10 **SECTION 2.** AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day after the date it is enacted.
