TITLE – Zoning - Port Covington Area of Special Signage Control - Amendment

PURPOSE – For the purpose of revising the criteria for the Port Covington Area of Special Signage Control; and providing for a special effective date.

COMMENTS – Council Bill 24-0500 clarifies the boundaries of the Port Covington Area of Special Signage Control by removing a reference to the 2017 Zoning Map. As per the zoning code (Article 32, § 17-505), the signs that may be erected in these areas must not contribute to traffic congestion or distracted driving. Therefore, provided that signs in the area abide by approved signage plans, any impact to roadway operations should be negligible.

DOT POSTION – The Department foresees no direct impact resulting from this legislation. Therefore, the Department has **no objection** to the advancement of Council Bill 24-0500.
