Recitals

~~Article VI, § 9(a)(2) of the City Charter provides that, on recommendation of the Board of Estimates, the City Council by ordinance may authorize the transfer of an appropriation contained in the Ordinance of Estimates from one municipal agency to another municipal agency:~~

~~The sum of \$5,251,429, as appropriated to the General Fund Balance in the Fiscal 2024 Ordinance of Estimates, is not needed for the purpose for which it was appropriated and; therefore, is available for transfer to another agency:~~

The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents \$5,251,429 in excess of the revenue relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2024.

This additional revenue could not have been reasonably anticipated when the Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2024 was formulated.

1 This appropriation is made necessary by a material change in circumstances since the
2 Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2024 was formulated or is for a new program that could
3 not have been reasonably anticipated when that Ordinance of Estimates was formulated.

4 On February 5, 2025, the Board of Estimates recommended the appropriation authorized by
5 this Ordinance.

6 ~~**SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the~~
7 ~~sum of \$5,251,429, contained in the Fiscal 2024 Ordinance of Estimates as a General Fund~~
8 ~~Appropriation, is transferred from the General Fund Balance to the Health Department~~
9 ~~(Service 315 - Emergency Medical Services).~~

10 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That
11 \$5,251,429 shall be made available to the Health Department – Service 315 (Emergency
12 Services) as a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2024, to
13 provide funding for reimburseable COVID-related contract costs. The source of revenue for this
14 appropriation is a fund balance in excess of the amount from this source that was relied on by the
15 Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year
16 2024.

17 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is
18 enacted.


