AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING

**General Fund Operating Appropriation Transfer –
Department of General Services to
Department of Law (Service 861 - Controversies) – \$1,514,351**

FOR the purpose of transferring a General Fund Operating Appropriation in the amount of \$1,514,351 from the Department of General Services to the Department of Law (Service 861 - Controversies); and providing for a special effective date.

Recitals

Article VI, § 9(a)(2) of the City Charter provides that, on recommendation of the Board of Estimates, the City Council by ordinance may authorize the transfer of an appropriation contained in the Ordinance of Estimates from one municipal agency to another municipal agency.

The sum of \$1,514,351, as appropriated to the Department of General Services in the Fiscal 2024 Ordinance of Estimates, is not needed for the purpose for which it was appropriated and, therefore, is available for transfer to another agency.

On February 5, 2025, the Board of Estimates recommended the transfer authorized by this Ordinance.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the sum of \$1,514,351, contained in the Fiscal 2024 Ordinance of Estimates as a General Fund Operating Appropriation, is transferred from the Department of General Services to the Department of Law (Service 861 - Controversies).


