1 AN ORDINANCE concerning

2 **Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation –**
3 **MR-Civic Promotion – \$105,000**

4 FOR the purpose of providing a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation in the
5 amount of \$105,000 to the MR-Civic Promotion – Program 590 (Civic Promotion), to
6 provide funding for Partnership for Baltimore’s Waterfront; and providing for a special
7 effective date.

13 **Recitals**

14 The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents funds from the FY 2005 General
15 Fund Balance in excess of the revenue relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax
16 levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2006.

17 This additional revenue could not have been reasonably anticipated when the Ordinance of
18 Estimates for Fiscal Year 2006 was formulated.

19 This appropriation is made necessary by a material change in circumstances since the
20 Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2006 was formulated or is for a new program that could
21 not have been reasonably anticipated when that Ordinance of Estimates was formulated.

22 On January 11, 2006, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City
23 Council.

24 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That**
25 **\$105,000 shall be made available to the MR-Civic Promotion – Program 590 (Civic Promotion)**
26 **as a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2006, to provide**

1 funding for Partnership for Baltimore's Waterfront. The source of revenue for this appropriation
2 is from the FY 2005 Fund Balance in excess of the amount from this source that was relied on by
3 the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year
4 2006.

5 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it
6 is enacted.
