22	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the
23	Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

§ 36B. Deferred Retirement Option Plan.

(a) Eligibility.

- (i) Any active employee who becomes a member of this system on or before June 30, 2003, and who has acquired at least 20 years of service AS OF JUNE 30, 2006, is eligible to participate in the DROP PROVIDED BY THIS § 36B by making an election in the manner prescribed in paragraph (iii) of this subsection. ANY MEMBER WHO DOES NOT MEET THE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS OF THIS § 36B, EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2006, WILL BE COVERED BY THE PROVISIONS OF § 36C OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- (ii) Any active employee who becomes a member of this system on or after July 1, 2003, and who, in addition to having acquired at least 20 years of service, has acquired at least 10 years of service as a contributing member of this system AS OF JUNE 30, 2006, is eligible to participate in the DROP by making an election in the manner prescribed in paragraph (iii) of this subsection.
- (c) Status of DROP participants.
 - (1) During DROP participation period.
 - (A) Notwithstanding any other provision of this subtitle to the contrary, a member shall remain a member of the Retirement System during the DROP participation period, provided, however, that the member shall not be credited with service during such period, and that, except with regard to the calculation of a member's intermediate DROP retirement benefit under subsection (f)(2), compensation, pay or salary earned during that period shall be disregarded in calculating the member's average final compensation.
 - (B) A member who becomes a participant in the DROP shall continue to make the contributions that are required under § 36(h) of this subtitle for members earning service credit. These contributions shall be accumulated in a subaccount within the Annuity Savings [Fund] RESERVE, but shall be credited with interest compounded annually in the same manner and at the same interest rate as though the contributions had been accumulated in the member's DROP account as provided under subsection (d). Contributions that are required under § 36(h) of this subtitle of any member entitled to protection of retirement benefits and credits on account of military service under § 32(e) of this subtitle, shall be paid by the system into the member's subaccount on his or her behalf for the duration of his or her absence from employment on account of military service.
 - (C) The contributions described in the preceding paragraph shall be treated as being "picked up" by the City of Baltimore within the meaning of § 414(h)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The contributions described in the preceding paragraph shall not be considered "accumulated contributions", as defined in § 30(10) of this subtitle.

1	(2) After DROP participation period.
2 3 4 5	(A) Any member who becomes a participant in the DROP may retire or terminate service, and thereby discontinue participation in the DROP, at any time during the DROP participation period or may retire or terminate service at the conclusion of that period.
6 7 8	(B) A member may elect to discontinue participation in the DROP and resume earning service credit in the system only as of the 1 st or 2 nd anniversary of the effective date of the member's DROP participation period.
9 10 11 12	(C) The election to discontinue participation shall be made on forms provided for that purpose by the Board of Trustees and shall be filed with the Board no less than 30 days AND NO MORE THAN 90 DAYS before the effective date of the discontinuance of participation.
13 14	(D) The additional accrual rate provided by $\S 36B(f)(2)$ or $\S 36B(G)(2)$ shall only be applied to the member's completed years of DROP participation.
15 16	(E) A member who continues employment at the conclusion of a full, 3-year DROP participation period shall resume earning service credit in the system.
17 18 19	(F) A member who becomes ineligible to participate in the DROP pursuant to subsection (a) or who elects to discontinue participation in the DROP pursuant to this subsection (b) may not elect to again participate in the DROP.
20	(e) Basic DROP retirement benefit.
21 22 23	Notwithstanding § 34(b) of this subtitle, any member who retires during or at the conclusion of a DROP participation period shall receive" a basic DROP retirement benefit" equal to:
24 25 26	(1) the service retirement allowance the member would have received under § 34(b) had the member retired from service and commenced a service retirement allowance on the effective date of the DROP participation period;
27 28	(2) the balance in the member's DROP account at the time of retirement, payable pursuant to the member's election under subsection (n) of this section; and
29 30 31	(3) the balance in the member's Annuity Savings [Fund] RESERVE subaccount accumulated under subsection (c) of this section, payable pursuant to the member's election under subsection (n) of this section.
32	(h) Non-line-of-duty disability benefit.
33 34	Notwithstanding § 34(d) of this subtitle, any member who retires on account of non-line-of-duty disability:
35 36 37	(1) during or at the conclusion of a DROP participation period, shall receive a non-line-of-duty disability benefit equal to the "basic DROP retirement benefit" provided under subsection (e) of this section;

1	(2) less than 18 months following the conclusion of a DROP participation period,
2	shall receive [an ordinary] A NON-LINE-OF-DUTY disability benefit equal to the
3	"intermediate DROP retirement benefit" provided under subsection (f) of this
4	section; and
5	(3) 18 or more months following the conclusion of a DROP participation period, shall
6	receive [an ordinary] A NON-LINE-OF-DUTY disability benefit equal to the "full
7	DROP retirement benefit" provided under subsection (g) of this section.
8	(i) Line-of-duty disability benefit.
9	Any member who retires on account of line-of-duty disability under [§ 34(f)] § 34(E-1)
10	OR (F-1) of this subtitle during or after a DROP participation period shall receive the line-
11	of-duty disability benefits provided under [§ 34(f)] § 34(E-1) OR (F-1) in place of any
12	DROP benefits provided by this § 36B (including any balance in the member's DROP
13	account and Annuity Savings [Fund] RESERVE subaccount), as though the member had
14	never participated in the DROP.
15	(j) Non-line-of-duty death benefit.
16	Notwithstanding § 34(h) of this subtitle, the non-line-of-duty death benefit payable on the
17	death of a member who dies during or after a DROP participation period shall equal the
18	non-line-of-duty death benefit provided in § 34(h), plus the balance of the member's
19	DROP account and Annuity Savings [Fund] RESERVE subaccount at the time of death,
20	subject to the following:
21	(4) for a recipient electing to receive non-line-of-duty death benefits under § 34(h)(1)
22	and (2) of this subtitle, the balance of the deceased member's DROP account and
23	Annuity Savings [Fund] RESERVE subaccount shall be payable in one lump sum;
24	(5) for a recipient electing to receive non-line-of-duty death benefits under § 34(h)(3)
25	of this subtitle, the balance of the deceased member's DROP account and Annuity
26	Savings [Fund] RESERVE subaccount shall be payable pursuant to the election of
27	the recipient under subsection (n) of this section; and
28	(6) for a recipient electing to receive non-line-of-duty death benefits under § 34(h)(4)
29	of this subtitle, the balance of the deceased member's DROP account and Annuity
30	Savings [Fund] RESERVE subaccount shall be payable pursuant to the election of
31	the recipient under subsection (n) of this section.
32	(k) Line-of-duty death benefit.
33	(2) Line-of-duty death benefit.
34	On the receipt of a written application, proper proof of death, and an award by
35	a hearing examiner of a line-of-duty death benefit as provided for in
36	paragraph (1) of this subsection, the Board of Trustees shall pay either:
37	(A) the ordinary death benefit payable on the death of a member under
38	subsection (j) of this section; or

1 2 3	(B) the line-of-duty death benefit payable under § 34(i) in lieu of any DROP benefits provided by this Section, including any balance in the member's DROP account and [annuity savings fund] ANNUITY
4 5	SAVINGS RESERVE subaccount, as though the member had never participated in the DROP.
6	(m) Post-retirement increases.
7	(1) [Notwithstanding § 36A of this subtitle, for] For a member who retires during or at
8	the conclusion of a DROP participation period, the member's DROP participation
9 10	period shall be counted toward the eligibility requirement for post-retirement benefit increases under [§ 36A] § 36A-1 OR § 36A-2, AS APPLICABLE.
11	(2) However, if a member resumes earning service credit following the conclusion of a
12 13	DROP participation period, then the DROP participation period shall not be counted toward the eligibility requirement for post-retirement increases.
14	(3) Post-retirement benefit increases for former DROP participants shall be applied
15	prospectively only (i.e., no increase shall be provided to make up for any
16	post-retirement benefit increases that the member would have received if the member
17	had retired from service in lieu of electing to participate in the DROP).
18	(4) If a member elects under subsection (n) to receive the balance of his or her DROP
19	account in the form of periodic payments, those payments shall be eligible for
20	post-retirement benefit increases under [§ 36A] § 36A-1 OR § 36A-2, AS APPLICABLE,
21 22	upon satisfaction by the member of the eligibility requirements of [§ 36A(a), as modified by this subsection (m)] § 36A-1(A) OR § 36A-2, AS APPLICABLE.
23	(n) Form of payment of DROP account balance.
24	[The total balance of a member's DROP account and Annuity Savings Fund subaccount
25	shall be payable in one lump sum as soon as administratively feasible after the member's
26	retirement or death. However, a member may elect to receive the actuarial equivalent of
27	that balance in the same form of periodic payments in which the member has elected to
28	receive the remainder of his or her retirement benefit; and upon the retired member's
29	death, the DROP account and the Annuity Savings Fund subaccount shall be paid in the
30	same manner as the member's Annuity Savings Fund account.]
31	(1) The election of the form of payment of the MEMBER'S DROP account balance shall be
32	made on forms provided by the Board of Trustees and shall be filed with the Board.
33	(2) A MEMBER OR A BENEFICIARY, IF APPLICABLE FOR BENEFITS PAYABLE UNDER \S 36b(j),
34	MAY ELECT TO RECEIVE HIS OR HER DROP ACCOUNT BALANCE IN EITHER:
35	(A) A LUMP SUM, WHICH CAN BE:
36	(I) TRANSFERRED OR ROLLED OVER IN TOTAL OR IN PART TO A FINANCIAL

7 8 9	(II) PAID IN THE SAME MANNER AS THE MEMBER'S ANNUITY SAVINGS RESERVE ACCOUNT, UPON THE DEATH OF THE RETIRED DROP PARTICIPANT.
10 11 12	(3) THE LUMP SUM PAYMENT OF THE MEMBER'S DROP ACCOUNT ELECTED UNDER PARAGRAPH (2)(A) OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE MADE AS SOON AS ADMINISTRATIVELY FEASIBLE AFTER THE MEMBER'S RETIREMENT OR DEATH.
13	(o) Conflicts in elections for death benefits.
14 15 16 17	In the event of conflicting death benefit elections under this subtitle, an election for [special] LINE-OF-DUTY death benefits made by an eligible surviving spouse shall override an election for [ordinary] NON-LINE-OF-DUTY death benefits made by a designated beneficiary.
18	§ 36C. Deferred Retirement Option Plan 2.
19	(A) Scope of Section.
20 21 22 23	Effective July 1, 2006, a member who is making regular mandatory contributions pursuant to \$36(h) may elect to become a participant in this Deferred Retirement Option Plan 2 (DROP 2), subject to the following provisions.
24	(b) Definitions.
25	(1) "DROP 2" means the benefits established under this \S 36C.
26 27	(2) "DROP 2 START DATE" MEANS THE FIRST DAY OF A MEMBER'S 3-YEAR DROP PARTICIPATION PERIOD.
28 29	(3) "DROP 2 END DATE" MEANS THE LAST DAY OF A MEMBER'S 3-YEAR DROP PARTICIPATION PERIOD.
30 31 32	(4) "DROP 2 PARTICIPATION PERIOD" MEANS A TIME PERIOD OF 3 CONSECUTIVE YEARS DURING WHICH DROP CONTRIBUTIONS AND BENEFITS ARE ACCUMULATED ON BEHALF OF A DROP PARTICIPANT.
33 34	(5) "DROP 2 participant" means a member who has elected to be covered by the benefits of this \S 36C.

1 2 3	(6) "DROP 2 interest rate", whenever used in this \S 36C, means regular interest for the Annuity Savings Reserve as defined in \S 30(9) of this subtitle.
4 5 6	(7) "EARLY DROP 2 SERVICE RETIREMENT" MEANS RETIREMENT WITH LESS THAN 6 YEARS OF SERVICE ACQUIRED THROUGH EMPLOYMENT COVERED BY THIS SYSTEM IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE MEMBER'S 3-YEAR DROP PARTICIPATION PERIOD.
7 8 9	(8) "Normal DROP 2 service retirement" means retirement with 6 or more years of service acquired through employment covered by this System immediately following the member's 3-year DROP participation period.
10	(c) Eligibility and application.
11 12 13 14 15	(1) Notwithstanding § 30(6) of this subtitle, an active employee who has acquired at least 20 years of continuous service through employment as a contributing member of this System is eligible to participate in this DROP 2 by making an election in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) of this subsection.
16	(2) An eligible member may elect to participate in DROP $2\mathrm{By}$:
17 18	(A) filing a written application on a form approved by the Board of Trustees,
19 20	(B) filing the application not less than 30 days nor more than 90 days before the member's DROP 2 start date, and
21	(C) SELECTING THE MEMBER'S DROP 2 START DATE.
22 23 24	(3) The election to participate in DROP 2 and the election to claim any benefit under this \S 36C must be made on forms provided for that purpose by the Board of Trustees and filed with the Board.
25 26	(4) A member's DROP 2 participation period always begins on the first day of a month.
27 28 29	(5) Any member in service who terminates employment, retires, or dies becomes ineligible to elect to participate or to continue participation in DROP 2.
30 31 32 33	(6) Any member who voluntarily or involuntarily terminates employment, or retires during the member's 3-year DROP 2 participation period shall not be entitled to any benefits under this § 36C and shall only be entitled to benefits under § 34 of this subtitle.
34 35	(7) A DROP 2 PARTICIPANT SHALL NOT BE PERMITTED TO DISCONTINUE DROP 2 PARTICIPATION AND REMAIN EMPLOYED.
36 37	(8) THE BENEFICIARY OR BENEFICIARIES OF ANY MEMBER WHO DIES DURING THE MEMBER'S 3-YEAR DROP 2 PARTICIPATION PERIOD SHALL NOT BE ENTITLED TO

1 2	benefits under this $\$36C$ and shall only be entitled to benefits under $\$34$ of this subtitle.
3 4 5	(9) Unless stated within this § 36C, the application requirements of § 34 of this subtitle apply to the applicable service retirement, disability retirement, and death benefits provided by this section.
6 7 8 9 10	(10) Notwithstanding \S 34(e-1)(2)(ii) and \S 34(f-1)(2)(ii), a DROP 2 participant may not file for line-of-duty disability retirement benefits under \S 36C(j) if the member has retired on a DROP 2 service retirement pursuant to \S 36C(g) or (h), or if the member has retired on a DROP 2 non-line-of-duty disability retirement benefit pursuant to \S 36C(i).
11 12	(11) A member who participates or has participated in the DROP provided by \S 36B may not participate in DROP 2.
13 14 15 16 17	(12) A MEMBER WHO BECOMES INELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN DROP 2 PURSUANT TO THIS SUBSECTION (C) OR A MEMBER WHO WAS ELIGIBLE TO HAVE PARTICIPATED IN EITHER THE DROP, PROVIDED BY § 36B, OR THIS DROP 2, BUT FAILED TO PARTICIPATE AND INSTEAD RETIRED OR TERMINATED EMPLOYMENT MAY NOT ELECT TO PARTICIPATE IN DROP 2 IF REEMPLOYED IN A POSITION COVERED BY THIS SYSTEM.
18 19 20 21	(13) A DROP 2 PARTICIPANT WHO RETIRES WITH A BENEFIT UNDER THIS SECTION IS SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF § 48 OF THIS ARTICLE CONCERNING CONTEMPORANEOUS MEMBERSHIP IN MORE THAN ONE CITY OF BALTIMORE RETIREMENT SYSTEM.
22	(D) Participation period, membership status, and service credits.
23 24 25	(1) A MEMBER'S DROP 2 PARTICIPATION PERIOD SHALL BE A SINGLE TERM OF 3 CONSECUTIVE YEARS COMMENCING WITH THE MEMBER'S DROP 2 START DATE, AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (C)(4) OF THIS SECTION.
26 27 28	(2) A member's DROP 2 participation period shall terminate if a member becomes ineligible to participate or to continue participation in DROP 2 pursuant to subsection $©$) of their section.
29 30	(3) A member shall remain an active member of this System during the member's DROP 2 participation period.
31 32	(4) A member shall not earn service credit for employment during the member's 3-year DROP 2 participation period.
33 34 35 36	(5) Notwithstanding paragraph (4) of this subsection, a DROP 2 participant may continue making voluntary contributions for the purchase of additional service credits as provided pursuant to \S 32 of this subtitle and subsection (e)(6) of this section.
37 38 39	(6) A MEMBER WHO CONTINUES EMPLOYMENT COVERED BY THIS SYSTEM AT THE CONCLUSION OF HIS OR HER 3-YEAR DROP 2 PARTICIPATION PERIOD SHALL RESUME EARNING SERVICE CREDIT IN THIS SYSTEM.

2 3 4	(1) A member who becomes a DROP 2 participant must continue to make the regular mandatory member contributions required under \S 36(h) of this Subtitle for members earning service credit.

7 8 9	(A) SHALL BE ACCUMULATED IN A SUBACCOUNT WITHIN THE ANNUITY SAVINGS RESERVE AND SHALL BE CREDITED TO THE MEMBER'S DROP 2 ACCOUNT DEFINED IN SUBSECTION (F) OF THIS SECTION; AND
10 11	(B) shall not be considered "accumulated contributions", as defined in § $30(10)$ of this subtitle.
12 13 14	(3) The contributions described in paragraph (1) of this subsection shall be treated as being "picked up" by the City of Baltimore within the meaning of § 414(h)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.
15 16 17 18 19 20	(4) Contributions that are required under § 36(h) of this subtitle of any member entitled to protection of retirement benefits and credits on account of military service under § 32(e) of this subtitle, shall be paid on behalf of the member by the System into the member's DROP 2 subaccount should the member be absent from employment on account of military service during the member's DROP participation period.
21 22 23	(5) Contributions required to be made by the member during the 3-year DROP 2 participation period shall be credited with interest compounded annually as provided under subsection (f) of this section.
24 25 26 27	(6) During the member's 3-year DROP 2 participation period, a member may continue to make voluntary contributions for the purchase or the transfer-in of service credits under § 32 of this subtitle. Voluntary contributions shall not be credited to the member's DROP 2 Account.
28 29 30 31 32	(7) A MEMBER WHO CONTINUES EMPLOYMENT AT THE CONCLUSION OF HER OR HIS 3-YEAR DROP 2 PARTICIPATION PERIOD SHALL CONTINUE MAKING REQUIRED MANDATORY MEMBER CONTRIBUTIONS. THESE CONTRIBUTIONS SHALL BE CREDITED TO THE MEMBER'S ANNUITY SAVINGS ACCOUNT AND SHALL BE "ACCUMULATED CONTRIBUTIONS".
33	(F) DROP 2 ACCOUNT.
34 35	(1) A DROP 2 ACCOUNT SHALL BE MAINTAINED FOR EACH MEMBER WHO BECOMES A DROP 2 PARTICIPANT. THE ACCOUNT SHALL COMPRISE:
36 37	(A) DROP 2 MEMBER CONTRIBUTIONS, WHICH SHALL BE MAINTAINED IN THE ANNUITY SAVINGS RESERVE, AND
