- This appropriation is made necessary by a material change in circumstances since the Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2005 was formulated or is for a new program that could not have been reasonably anticipated when that Ordinance of Estimates was formulated.
- On April 12, 2006, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City

- SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That \$412,000 shall be made available to the MR-Board of Estimates – Program 122 (Miscellaneous General Expenses) as a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2006, to provide funds for the After School Matters Program.
