| 12 | (3) otherwise to promote activity of a business or commercial nature. |
| 13 | (c) Person. |
| 14 | (1) In general. |
| 15 | "Person" means, except as specified in paragraph (2) of this subsection: |
| 16 | (i) any individual; and |
| 17 | (ii) any partnership, firm, association, corporation, or other entity of any kind. |

| 19 20 | "Person" does not include a governmental entity or an instrumentality or unit of a governmental entity. |
