17	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That as evidence of the authenticity of the
18	accompanying plat and in order to give notice to the agencies that administer the City Zoning

17 18 Ordinance: (i) when the City Council passes this Ordinance, the President of the City Council 19 shall sign the plat; (ii) when the Mayor approves this Ordinance, the Mayor shall sign the plat; 20 and (iii) the Director of Finance then shall transmit a copy of this Ordinance and the plat to the 21 Board of Municipal and Zoning Appeals, the Planning Commission, the Commissioner of 22 Housing and Community Development, the Supervisor of Assessments for Baltimore City, and 23 the Zoning Administrator. 24

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day 25 after the date it is enacted. 26
