12	The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents funds from the Transfer Tax in excess
13	of the revenue relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to
14	balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2006.
15	This additional revenue could not have been reasonably anticipated when the Ordinance of
16	Estimates for Fiscal Year 2006 was formulated.
17	This appropriation is made necessary by a material change in circumstances since the
18	Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2006 was formulated or is for a new program that could
19	not have been reasonably anticipated when that Ordinance of Estimates was formulated.
20	On April 12, 2006, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City
21	Council.
22	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That
23	\$750,000 shall be made available to the MR-Art and Culture – Program 493 (Art and Culture
24	Grants) as a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2006, to
