10 11	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

14	Subtitle 48. Sporting Events
15	[§ 48-2. Resale near stadiums.
16	(a) Prohibited conduct.
17	On any public right-of-way within 1 mile of the outer perimeter of the Baltimore Arena
18	or of the Camden Yard Sports Complex (which includes the Orioles' Ballpark and the
19	Ravens' Stadium), a person may not offer for resale any ticket to any sporting or other
20	event that takes place at the Baltimore Arena or the Camden Yard Sports Complex.
21	(b) Enforcement by citation.
22	(1) In addition to any other civil or criminal remedy or enforcement procedure, this
23	section may be enforced by issuance of:

1 2	(i) an environmental citation under City Code Article 1, Subtitle 40 {"Environmental Control Board"}; or
3	(ii) a civil citation under City Code Article 1, Subtitle 41 {"Civil Citations"}.
4 5	(2) The issuance of a citation to enforce this section does not preclude pursuing any other civil or criminal remedy or enforcement action authorized by law.
6	(c) Penalties.
7 8	Any person who violates any provision of this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and, on conviction, is subject to a fine of not more than \$50 for each offense.]
9 10 11	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED , That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior Ordinance.
12 13	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED , That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30 th day after the date it is enacted.
