### **AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING**

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### Rezoning – 1834 and 1841-1847 Jackson Street

- Jackson Street, as outlined in red on the accompanying plat, from the M-2-2 Zoning District
  to the R-8 Zoning District.

#### 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That

12 Sheet 66 of the Zoning District Maps is amended by changing from the M-2-2 Zoning District to

13 the R-8 Zoning District the properties known as 1834 and 1841-1847 Jackson Street, as outlined

14 in red on the plat accompanying this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That as evidence of the authenticity of the 15 accompanying plat and in order to give notice to the agencies that administer the City Zoning 16 Ordinance: (i) when the City Council passes this Ordinance, the President of the City Council 17 shall sign the plat; (ii) when the Mayor approves this Ordinance, the Mayor shall sign the plat; 18 and (iii) the Director of Finance then shall transmit a copy of this Ordinance and the plat to the 19 Board of Municipal and Zoning Appeals, the Planning Commission, the Commissioner of 20 Housing and Community Development, the Supervisor of Assessments for Baltimore City, and 21 the Zoning Administrator. 22

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS indicate matter added to existing law. [Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law. <u>Underlining</u> indicates matter added to the bill by amendment. Strike out indicates matter stricken from the bill by amendment or deleted from existing law by amendment.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30<sup>th</sup> day
 after the date it is enacted.
