4	Section 115 Unsafe Structures		
5 6 7	115.4 Unsafe vacant structures. Every vacant structure, as defined in this § 115.4, is declared to be a fire hazard and a nuisance per se, and must be safeguarded and otherwise maintained as required in this § 115.4.		
8	115.4.1 Definition. "Vacant structure" means an unoccupied structure that is unsafe or unfit for human habitation or other authorized use.		
10 11 12	115.4.6 Notice to Public Works. Whenever the Building Official determines a structure to be vacant, the Building Official must promptly notify the Director of Public Works of that determination.

23 24	(I) FOR A STRUCTURE THAT HAS AN ACCESSIBLE WATER METER, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL CUT OFF THE WATER TO THE PREMISES; OR		
25 26 27	(II) FOR A STRUCTURE THAT DOES NOT HAVE AN ACCESSIBLE WATER METER, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL CUT OFF THE WATER TO THE PREMISES IF DAMAGE TO ADJACENT PROPERTY IS IMMINENT OR DEMOLITION OF THE PROPERTY IS PLANNED.

29 30 31	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED , That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior Ordinance.		
32 33	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED , That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30 th day after the date it is enacted.
