18	Estimates for Fiscal Year 2007 was formulated.
19	This appropriation is made necessary by a material change in circumstances since the
20	Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2007 was formulated or is for a new program that could
21	not have been reasonably anticipated when that Ordinance of Estimates was formulated.
22	On May 9, 2007, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City

24	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That
25	\$175,000 shall be made available to the Department of Health – Program 310 (School Health
26	Services) as a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2007, to
27	provide funding for training to support the upgrade of skills of Baltimore City residents who
