- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That 12 permission is granted for the establishment, maintenance, and operation of a parking, open off-
- permission is granted for the establishment, maintenance, and operation of a parking, open of street area on the property known as 1601 North Dallas Street, as outlined in red on the plat
- accompanying this Ordinance, in accordance with Baltimore City Zoning Code §§ 4-1104 and
- 15 14-102, subject to the condition that the parking, open off-street area complies with all
- applicable federal, state, and local licensing and certification requirements.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That as evidence of the authenticity of the 17 accompanying plat and in order to give notice to the agencies that administer the City Zoning 18 Ordinance: (i) when the City Council passes this Ordinance, the President of the City Council 19 shall sign the plat; (ii) when the Mayor approves this Ordinance, the Mayor shall sign the plat; 20 and (iii) the Director of Finance then shall transmit a copy of this Ordinance and the plat to the 21 Board of Municipal and Zoning Appeals, the Planning Commission, the Commissioner of 22 Housing and Community Development, the Supervisor of Assessments for Baltimore City, and 23 the Zoning Administrator. 24
