2 3	For the purpose of repealing the prohibition against reselling, in certain proximity to certain venues, tickets to events at those venues.

9 10	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

12	Article 19. Police Ordinances
13	Subtitle 48. Sporting Events
14	[§ 48-2. Resale near stadiums.
15	(a) Prohibited conduct.
16 17 18 19	On any public right-of-way within 1 mile of the outer perimeter of the Baltimore Arena or of the Camden Yard Sports Complex (which includes the Orioles' Ballpark and the Ravens' Stadium), a person may not offer for resale any ticket to any sporting or other event that takes place at the Baltimore Arena or the Camden Yard Sports Complex.
20	(b) <i>Enforcement by citation</i> .
21 22	(1) In addition to any other civil or criminal remedy or enforcement procedure, this section may be enforced by issuance of:

6	(c) Penalties.
7 8	Any person who violates any provision of this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and, on conviction, is subject to a fine of not more than \$50 for each offense.]
9 10 11	<b>SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED</b> , That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior Ordinance.
12	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30 <sup>th</sup> day

13 after the date it is enacted.
