16	Estimates for Fiscal Year 2007 was formulated.		
17	This appropriation is made necessary by a material change in circumstances since the		
18	Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2007 was formulated or is for a new program that could		
19	not have been reasonably anticipated when that Ordinance of Estimates was formulated.		
20	On May 9, 2007, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City		
21	Council.		
22	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That		
23	\$4,800,000 shall be made available to the Fire Department – Program 212 (Fire Suppression) as		
24	a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2007, to provide
