BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the 11 Laws of Baltimore City read as follows: 12 **Baltimore City Code** 13 Article 31. Transit and Traffic 14 Subtitle 1. Definitions; General Provisions 15 § 1-1. Definitions – A to L. 16 (p) Lane. 17 "Lane" means any section of a roadway [which] THAT is clearly delineated from the other 18 sections of [said] THAT roadway by lines, markings, or physical barriers. 19 Subtitle 6. 2	(a)	2-way streets.
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3	(1) [In] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, [all cases] where
4	any vehicle is stopped or parked [upon] ON a 2-way roadway, the VEHICLE'S
5	right-hand wheels [of said vehicle] shall be parallel to and within 12 inches of the
6	right-hand curb or edge of the roadway.
7	(2) HOWEVER, WHERE ANY VEHICLE IS STOPPED OR PARKED ON A 2-WAY ROADWAY THAT
