SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That, in accordance with Article V, § 5(b) of the City Charter, the City Comptroller may sell, at either public or private sale, all the interest of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore in the property , known as NWS Pulaski Highway NEC of Moravia Park Drive (Block 6202, Sheets 3 and 4, Portion of Lot 2/22) and more particularly described as follows:

- containing 19,032 square feet, more or less, or 0.4369 acres, this property being no longer
 needed for public use.
