BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That, in accordance with Article V, § 5(b) of the City Charter, the City Comptroller may sell, at either public or private sale, all the interest of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore in the property located at 1101 North Wolfe Street (Block 1550, Lot 1), formerly known as the Elmer Henderson Elementary School, and more particularly described as follows:

 19 1550, Lot 1, improved lot. The site is bounded by East Biddle Street on the north,
 20 East Chase Street on the south, North Washington Street on the east, and North
 21 Wolfe Street on the west,
