2	have not yet been achieved, in which case this subtitle may be extended for 5 more years.
3	HOWEVER, IF BY DECEMBER 6, 2007, THE CITY COUNCIL FAILS TO ENACT A 5-YEAR OR OTHER
4	long-term extension, then this subtitle is further extended through May $30$ ,
5	2008, AND AUTOMATICALLY EXPIRES ON MAY 30, 2008, UNLESS A LONG-TERM EXTENSION IS
6	ENACTED BEFORE THEN.
