1. The building setback from the front is 0 feet.
2. The building setback from the interior is 5 feet.
3. The building setback from the street is 0 feet.
4. The building setback from the rear is 0 feet.
5. THE ALLOWABLE FAR IS 2.4.
6. The parking requirement is 0.
7. There may be no exterior sign on the facility other <u>Than a nameplate no larger than 12 inches wide by 12</u> <u>Inches high.</u>
8. The home for homeless persons must comply with all <u>Applicable federal</u> , state, and local licensing and <u>certification requirements</u> .
