AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING

Sale of Property – the Former Beds of Certain Streets and Alleys Lying Within the Area Bounded by 24th Street, Howard Street, 25th Street and Maryland Avenue

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to sell, at either public or private sale, all its interest in certain parcels of land known as the former beds of certain streets and alleys lying within the area bounded by 24th Street, Howard Street, 25th Street and Maryland Avenue and no longer needed for public use; and providing for a special effective date.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That, in accordance with Article V, § 5(b) of the City Charter, the City Comptroller may sell, at either public or private sale, all the interest of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore in certain

parcels of land known as the former beds of certain streets and alleys lying within the area

bounded by 24th Street, Howard Street, 25th Street and Maryland Avenue, and more particularly

18 described as follows:

Beginning for Parcel No. 1 at the point formed by the intersection of the north 19 side of 24th Street, 66 feet wide, and the west side of the former bed of Mace 20 Street, 20 feet wide, and running thence binding on the west side of the former 21 bed of said Mace Street, Northerly 465.0 feet, more or less, to intersect the south 22 side of 25th Street, 100 feet wide; thence binding on the south side of said 25th 23 Street, Easterly 20.0 feet to intersect the east side of the former bed of said Mace 24 Street; thence binding on the east side of the former bed of said Mace Street, 25 Southerly 465.0 feet, more or less, to intersect the north side of said 24th Street, 26 and thence binding on the north side of said 24th Street, Westerly 20.0 feet to the 27 28 place of beginning.

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Beginning for Parcel No. 2 at the point formed by the intersection of the north 1 2 side of 24th Street, 66 feet wide, and the east side of the former bed of a 10 foot 3 alley laid out in the rear of the properties formerly known as Nos. 2400 through 2424 Maryland Avenue, said point of beginning being distant westerly 84.0 feet, 4 more or less, measured along the north side of said 24th Street from the west side 5 6 of Maryland Avenue, 66 feet wide, and running thence binding on the north side 7 of said 24th Street, Westerly 10.0 feet to intersect the west side of the former bed 8 of said 10 foot alley; thence binding on the west side of the former bed of said 10 foot alley, Northerly 184.0 feet, more or less, to the northernmost extremity of the 9 former bed of said 10 foot alley; thence binding on the northernmost extremity of 10 the former bed of said 10 foot alley, Easterly 10.0 feet to intersect the east side of 11 the former bed of said 10 foot alley, and thence binding on the east side of the 12 13 former bed of said 10 foot alley, Southerly 184.0 feet, more or less, to the place of beginning. 14

Beginning for Parcel No. 3 at the point formed by the intersection of the south 15 side of the former bed of a 12 foot to varying in width alley laid out along the 16 northern outline of the property known as No. 2403/17 Mace Street, and the east 17 side of the former bed of Mace Street, 20 feet wide, said point of beginning being 18 northerly 172.0 feet, more or less, measured along the east side of the former bed 19 of said Mace Street from the north side of 24th Street, 66 feet wide, and running 20 thence binding on the east side of the former bed of said Mace Street, Northerly 21 12.0 feet to intersect the north side of the former bed of said 12 foot to varying in 22 width alley; thence binding on the north side of the former bed of said 12 foot to 23 varying in width alley, Easterly 56.0 feet, more or less, to intersect the west side 24 of the former bed of a 10 foot alley laid out in the rear of the properties formerly 25 known as Nos. 2400 through 2424 Maryland Avenue; thence binding on the west 26 side of the former bed of said 10 foot alley, Southerly 22.0 feet, more or less, to 27 intersect the southeast side of the former bed of said 12 foot to varying in width 28 alley; thence binding on the southeast side of the former bed of said 12 foot to 29 30 varying in width alley, Northwesterly 14.1 feet, more or less, to the south side of the former bed of said 12 foot to varying in width alley, and thence binding on the 31 south side of the former bed of said 12 foot to varying in width alley, Westerly 32 33 46.0 feet, more or less, to the place of beginning.

Beginning for Parcel No. 4 at the point formed by the intersection of the south 34 side of the former bed of a 10 foot alley laid out in the rear of the property known 35 as No. 102 W. 24th Street, and the east side of the former bed of Mace Street, 20 36 feet wide, said point of beginning being distant northerly 65.0 feet, more or less, 37 measured along the east side of the former bed of said Mace Street from the north 38 side of 24th Street, 66 feet wide, and running thence binding on the east side of 39 the former bed of said Mace Street, Northerly 10.0 feet to intersect the north side 40 of the former bed of said 10 foot alley; thence binding on the north side of the 41 former bed of said 10 foot alley, Easterly 56.0 feet, more or less, to intersect the 42 west side of the former bed of a 10 foot alley laid out in the rear of the properties 43 44 formerly known as No. 2400 through 2424 Maryland Avenue; thence binding on the west side of the former bed of said 10 foot alley, mentioned secondly herein, 45 Southerly 10.0 feet to intersect the south side of the former bed of said 10 foot 46 alley, mentioned firstly herein, and thence binding on the south side of the former 47 48 bed of said 10 foot alley, mentioned firstly herein, Westerly 56.0 feet, more or less, to the place of beginning. 49

Beginning for Parcel No. 5 at the point formed by the intersection of the south 1 side of the former bed of a 10 foot alley laid out along the northern outline of the 2 3 properties formerly known as No. 2413 N. Howard Street and No. 2402 Mace Street, and the east side of Howard Street, 66 feet wide, said point of beginning 4 being distant northerly 102.0 feet, more or less, measured along the east side of 5 said Howard Street from the north side of 24th Street, 66 feet wide, and running 6 thence binding on the east side of said Howard Street, Northerly 10.0 feet to 7 8 intersect the north side of the former bed of said 10 foot alley; thence binding on the north side of the former bed of said 10 foot alley, Easterly 150.0 feet, more or 9 less, to intersect the west side of the former bed of said Mace Street, 20 feet wide; 10 thence binding on the west side of the former bed of said Mace Street, Southerly 11 10.0 feet to intersect the south side of the former bed of said 10 foot alley, and 12 13 thence binding on the south side of the former bed of said 10 foot alley, Westerly 150.0 feet, more or less, to the place of beginning. 14

- Beginning for Parcel No. 6 at the point formed by the intersection of the south 15 side of the former bed of a 5 foot alley laid out in the rear of the properties 16 formerly known as Nos. 114 through 130 W. 24th Street, and the east side of 17 Howard Street, 66 feet wide, said point of beginning being distant northerly 70.0 18 feet, more or less, measured along the east side of said Howard Street from the 19 north side of 24th Street, 66 feet wide, and running thence binding on the east 20 side of said Howard Street, Northerly 5.0 feet to intersect the north side of the 21 former bed of said 5 foot alley; thence binding on the north side of the former bed 2.2 of said 5 foot alley, Easterly 128.0 feet, more or less, to the easternmost extremity 23 of the former bed of said 5 foot alley; thence binding on the easternmost 24 extremity of the former bed of said 5 foot alley, Southerly 5.0 feet to intersect the 25 south side of the former bed of said 5 foot alley, and thence binding on the south 26 side of the former bed of said 5 foot alley, Westerly 128.0 feet, more or less, to 27 the place of beginning. 28
- 29 Beginning for Parcel No. 7 at the point formed by the intersection of the north side of the former bed of a 10 foot alley laid out along the south outline of the 30 property formerly known as No. 2415 N. Howard Street, and the west side of the 31 former bed of a 10 foot alley laid out in the rear of the properties formerly known 32 as Nos. 2415 through 2429 N. Howard Street, said point of beginning being 33 distant easterly 75.0 feet, more or less, measured along the south outline of the 34 property formerly known as No. 2415 N. Howard Street from the east side of said 35 Howard Street, and running thence binding on the west side of the former bed of 36 said 10 foot alley, mentioned secondly herein, Northerly 103.0 feet, more or less, 37 to the northernmost extremity of the former bed of said 10 foot alley, mentioned 38 secondly herein; thence binding on the northernmost extremity of the former bed 39 of said 10 foot alley, mentioned secondly herein, Easterly 10.0 feet to intersect the 40 east side of the former bed of said 10 foot alley, mentioned secondly herein; 41 thence binding on the east side of the former bed of said 10 foot alley, mentioned 42 secondly herein, Southerly 103.0 feet, more or less, to intersect the north side of 43 44 the former bed of said 10 foot alley, mentioned firstly herein, and thence binding on the north side of the former bed of said 10 foot alley, mentioned firstly herein, 45 Westerly 10.0 feet to the place of beginning. 46
- 47 Beginning for Parcel No. 8 at the point formed by the intersection of the north 48 side of the former bed of a 5 foot alley laid out in the rear of the properties

| 16 | said 5 foot alley, mentioned firstly herein, Westerly 5.0 feet to the place of |
| 17 | beginning. |

18 Subject to a full width Perpetual Easement for all Municipal Utilities and Services, not to be 19 abandoned, over the entire hereinabove described parcel of land.

20 This property being no longer needed for public use.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That no deed may pass under this Ordinance 22 unless the deed has been approved by the City Solicitor.

23 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it 24 is enacted.
