## AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING

## Zoning – Conditional Use Second-hand Store – 6643 Belair Road

FOR the purpose of permitting, subject to certain conditions, the establishment, maintenance, and
operation of a second-hand store on the property known as 6643 Belair Road, as outlined in
red on the accompanying plat.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That 12 permission is granted for the establishment, maintenance, and operation of a second-hand store 13 on the property known as 6643 Belair Road, as outlined in red on the plat accompanying this 14 Ordinance, in accordance with Baltimore City Zoning Code §§ 6-309(12a) and 14-102, subject

to the condition that the second-hand store complies with all applicable federal, state, and local

16 licensing and certification requirements.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED. That as evidence of the authenticity of the 17 accompanying plat and in order to give notice to the agencies that administer the City Zoning 18 Ordinance: (i) when the City Council passes this Ordinance, the President of the City Council 19 shall sign the plat; (ii) when the Mayor approves this Ordinance, the Mayor shall sign the plat; 20 and (iii) the Director of Finance then shall transmit a copy of this Ordinance and the plat to the 21 Board of Municipal and Zoning Appeals, the Planning Commission, the Commissioner of 22 Housing and Community Development, the Supervisor of Assessments for Baltimore City, and 23 the Zoning Administrator. 24

25 **SECTION 3.** AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30<sup>th</sup> day 26 after the date it is enacted.
