10	Recitals
11	Ordinance 83-998 (the "Ordinance") authorizes the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to
12	issue from time to time its Revenue Obligations (as defined in the Ordinance) to finance Parking
13	Facilities (as defined in the Ordinance) within the geographical limits of the City.
14	The aggregate principal amount of Revenue Obligations authorized by the Ordinance was
15	\$30,000,000. Subsequently, the aggregate principal amount of Revenue Obligations authorized

to be issued under the Ordinance was increased by Ordinance 84-067 to \$60,000,000, by

- 17 Ordinance 84-221 to \$76,000,000, by Ordinance 85-573 to \$93,000,000, by Ordinance 86-702
- to \$108,000,000, by Ordinance 87-1036 to \$120,000,000, by Ordinance 88-141 to \$150,000,000,
- and most recently by Ordinance 98-276 to \$225,000,000.

Certain events that have occurred since passage of the Ordinance affect the aggregate
principal amount of Revenue Obligations that may be required to finance Parking Facilities in
the City. Accordingly, the City seeks to increase to \$246,000,000 the aggregate principal
amount of Revenue Obligations that may be issued under the Ordinance.

24 SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the 25 Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

3	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That:
4	(A) (1) The issuance, sale, and delivery of an aggregate principal amount
5	of Revenue Obligations which, when issued, will result in receipt by the City
6	(inclusive of Costs of Issuance, as defined herein) of not exceeding [Two
7	Hundred Twenty-Five Million Dollars (\$225,000,000)] Two HUNDRED FORTY-
8	SIX MILLION DOLLARS (\$246,000,000) is hereby authorized for the general public
9	purposes of financing the cost of Parking Development Activities at or
10	for Parking Facilities owned by the City, the proceeds of which are to finance
11	the applicable Parking Development Activities, and repaying the City for
12	amounts expended on Parking Facilities in anticipation of the issuance of the
13	Revenue Obligations. This maximum amount may consist of (i) Revenue
14	Notes, (ii) Revenue Bonds, (iii) Refunding Revenue Notes, (iv) Refunding
15	Revenue Bonds, or (v) any combination of items (i) to (iv) above.
16	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That Ordinance 83-998, as last amended by
17	this Ordinance, remains in full force and effect.
18	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it
