Transit and Traffic – Bike Lanes

The Baltimore Development Corporation (BDC) -has reviewed City Council Bill 09-0430: Transit and Traffic – Bike Lanes. The Bill defines the appearance of and rules related to new bike lanes.

Improving infrastructure for cyclists helps to improve the livability of the Baltimore's neighborhoods by providing additional transportation options for the city's residents.
