AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING

Sale of Property – NS Eastern Avenue 402-9 Feet West East of 1 Kane Street (Block 6345D, Lot 9) 2 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to sell, at either public 3 or private sale, all its interest in certain property known as the NS Eastern Avenue 402-9 feet 4 west east of Kane Street (Block 6345D, Lot 9) and no longer needed for public use; and 5 6 providing for a special effective date. By authority of 7 Article V - Comptroller 8 Section 5(b) 9 10 Baltimore City Charter (1996 Edition) 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That, in 12 accordance with Article V, \S 5(b) of the City Charter, the City Comptroller may sell, at either 13 public or private sale, all the interest of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore in the property 14 known as the NS Eastern Avenue 402-9 feet west east of Kane Street (Block 6345D, Lot 9), and 15 more particularly described as follows: 16 The subject parcel (Block 6345D, Lot 9) is an unimproved lot, containing 9.385 17 acres. 18 Subject to a Perpetual Easement for all Municipal Utilities and Services, not to be 19 abandoned, over the entire hereinabove parcel of land. 20 This property being no longer needed for public use. 21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That no deed may pass under this Ordinance 22 unless the deed has been approved by the City Solicitor. 23 24 **SECTION 3.** AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED. That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is enacted. 25
