#### **City Streets – Bike-Safe Grates**

16	§ 18-11. "Bike-safe" grates required.
17	(A) BIKE-SAFE GRATE DEFINED.
18	For purposes of this section "bike-safe grate" means a drainage grate that:
19	(1) has bars running perpendicular to the flow of traffic;
20	(2) CONSISTS OF A GRATING COMPOSED OF INTERSECTING BARS; OR

15	ALL DRAINAGE GRATES IN THE AFFECTED AREA ARE PLACED SO THAT THE GAPS BETWEEN
