The Baltimore City Health Department (BCHD) has reviewed Council Bill 10-0530- Zoning - Conditional Use Community Correction Center - 4900 East Monument Street. The purpose of this bill is to establish a community correction center on the property known as 4900 East Monument Street which is to be run by the Volunteers of America of the Chesapeake, Inc. in accordance with Baltimore City Zoning Code §§ 7-408(1) and 14-102, and subject to all applicable federal, state, and local licensing and certification requirements.

The Health Department's Environmental Health Division has oversight of all newly built or renovated commercial kitchens within Baltimore City and must ensure compliance with the Code of Maryland Regulations and the Baltimore City Health Code. The Plans Examiner's office is charged with ensuring compliance with City Building Codes. As this project progresses, the Volunteers of America of the Chesapeake, Inc. are encouraged to consult with the Health Department's plan review to ensure compliance with applicable health code for commercial kitchens. However, in regards to other compliance issues, the Health Department defers to those agencies with jurisdiction over such matters.

The Health Department has no opposition to Council Bill 10-0530 with the provision that the property is in compliance with all applicable federal, state, and local licensing and certification requirements.
