13 14	The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents a grant from Federal Revenue administered through the Maryland Energy Administration in excess of the revenue relied on by
15 16	the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2011.
17 18	That grant could not have been expected with reasonable certainty when the Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2011 was formulated.
19	On October 13, 2010, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City
20	Council.
21	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That
22	\$750,000 shall be made available to the Department of General Services (Program #9916) as a
23	Supplementary Federal Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2011, to provide funding for the "Project
24	Sunburst" Grant. The source of revenue for this appropriation is the grant from Federal Revenue
25	administered through the Maryland Energy Administration in excess of the amount from this
26	source that was relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to

balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2011.
