23	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That
24	\$500,000 shall be made available to the Department of Planning (Account #9905-922004-9188)
25	as a Supplementary Capital Fund Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2011, to provide funds for the
26	Critical Area Buffer Offset Program. The source of revenue for this appropriation is other funds
27	to be established for the Critical Area Buffer Offset Program in excess of the amount from this
