12	The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents other funds to be established for the
13	Critical Area Buffer Offset Program in excess of the revenue relied on by the Board of Estimates
14	in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2011.
15	This additional revenue could not have been reasonably anticipated when the Ordinance of
16	Estimates for Fiscal Year 2011 was formulated.
17	This appropriation is made necessary by a material change in circumstances since the
18	Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2011 was formulated or is for a new program that could
19	not have been reasonably anticipated when that Ordinance of Estimates was formulated.
20	On October 13, 2010, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City
21	Council.
22	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That
23	\$500,000 shall be made available to the Department of Planning (Account #9905-922004-9188)
24	as a Supplementary Capital Fund Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2011, to provide funds for the
25	Critical Area Buffer Offset Program. The source of revenue for this appropriation is other funds
